



Tie the next square knot below the bead, starting with the tying cord that you left off with. The two tying cords will hug the bead.

Pull the knot tight so it touches the bead.

Continue to Slide the clasp create alternating bead chosen in knots (and step 2 onto all optionally adding four cords. beads) until you have reached the desired length of the piece.

Tie an overhand Cut the excess knot with all four cord off. cords flush against the clasp bead. Pull the knot tight.
